



**VILLAGE OF RYCROFT
BYLAW NO. 205-19**

BEING A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF RYCROFT IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO AUTHORIZE THE COUNCIL TO AMEND BYLAW 191-17, A LOCAL IMPROVEMENT TAX LEVY BYLAW.

WHEREAS, the *Municipal Government Act*, RSA 2000, Chapter M-26 as amended, authorizes the Council to pass, repeal or amend any bylaw.

NOW THEREFORE under the authority of the *Municipal Government Act* RSA 2000, Chapter M-26, the Council of the Village of Rycroft, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled enacts as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as the **“LOCAL IMPROVEMENT TAX LEVY BYLAW AMENDMENT BYLAW 205-19”**.
2. That the Local Improvement Tax Levy Bylaw 191-17 is hereby amended to read “The local improvement tax will be collected for the thirty (30) years and the total amount levied annually against the benefit owners is \$5.26 per frontage/flankage foot”.
3. Severability: If any portion of this bylaw is declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, then the invalid portion must be severed and the remainder of the bylaw is deemed valid.

Effective Date:


This Bylaw comes into effect upon third and final reading hereof.
