Community Futures sent us some Client Packages for distribution to interested entrepreneurs. The package includes information on how to start a business, loan information, business plan guide, and other information on starting up a business. The packages are available at the office. They do not have an entrepreneur grant program for the purpose of allowing potential businesses to develop business cases, but they do offer advice and assistance on small business start up.

We advertised the ATCO Electric Franchise Fee increase in 2 issues of the newspaper and received no response. That will move forward for final approval. Once that is complete, we will have the final 2 readings of BYLAW 217-20 ATCO Electric Franchise Agreement Bylaw, likely in late May or June.

We sent a letter of support to the Arena Board for their application to the Coop New Horizons Community grant program for the renovation of the lobby and changerooms project.

At the G5 Peace Regional Water Study meeting, Saddle Hills County Reeve Alvin Hubert was elected the Chairman, and MD of Spirit River Reeve Tony Van Rootselaar was elected Vice Chairman.

At the G5 Economic Development Advisory Committee meeting, the committee gave direction to organize a Social Mixer for regional businesses. This is tentatively scheduled for July.
