The garbage collection contract is over December 31, 2020. I am preparing an RFP to put the job out for bids. I did check with the Town of Spirit River but they signed a contract with Prairie Disposal in February 2019.

The total amount that we are eligible to apply for for the Municipal Stimulus Program grant is \$72,748. A Request for Decision is on the agenda.

ATCO has agreed to put a streetlight at the corner of Highway 2 and 45 avenue when they do the electrical substation expansion project in 2022.

Due to the late approval of the Alberta Municipal Water/Wastewater Partnership grant, we will not be proceeding with the construction of the sewer lift station project until 2021. This is so we do not rush the project and get inflated bids due to the fact that everyone is already working on their project deadlines. Our consultant Urban System advises “we believe this will result in the best outcome for the Village both in terms of cost and quality”.

The potential buyer has applied for a development permit to place a modular home on the residential lot located at 4624 46 street. Once that is approved, he can proceed with the sale.
