Our Statement of Funding and Expenditures (SFE) has been certified for the Storm Water Management Plan project, 1819-IC-9, funded by the Alberta Community Partnership (ACP). The Medical Clinic Governance ACP grant remains uncertified.

For the Fall Clean up September 10 to 15, we placed personnel on site to assist in directing patrons. The advantage to this is we ensure the proper waste is in the proper containers such as mixed waste, metals, recyclables, etc. Also, we can divert materials to save us space and cost. For example, if someone comes with a truck load of tree branches, we divert them to our organic materials dump site. Or if someone comes with a truckload of metal, we can send them across the road to Curry's, so we do not pay the cost of disposal. It is an education process.

We recorded 59 different patrons that dumped off at the bins. 53 gave us a Village of Rycroft address; 3 gave us Village business operations; 2 gave us MD of Spirit River addresses; and one was Town of Spirit River Resident.

A new development permit was approved for a single detached dwelling at 4615 49 street, and also at 4628 53 street.

We have advertised the Solid waste and Recyclable materials contract. RFP closed October 1. A report is forthcoming.
