

VILLAGE OF RYCROFT **BYLAW NO. 231-21**

"BORROWING BYLAW AMENDMENT"

BEING A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF RYCROFT IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO AMEND BORROWING BYLAW 188-17 TO INCLUDE THE SOURCES OF MONEY TO BE USED TO PAY BACK THE PRINCIPAL AND INTEREST OWING.

WHEREAS, the Municipal Government Act, RSA 2000, Chapter M-26 as amended, authorizes the Council to pass, repeal or amend any bylaw.

NOW THEREFORE under the authority of the Municipal Government Act RSA 2000, Chapter M-26, the Council of the Village of Rycroft, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled enacts as follows:

- 1. This Bylaw may be cited as the "BORROWING BYLAW AMENDMENT".
- 2. The bylaw shall be amended by inserting the following at the end of section 2:

The source of money to be used to repay the principal and interest owing on the loan shall be general and local improvement taxation.

- 3. Severability: If any portion of this bylaw is declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, then the invalid portion must be severed, and the remainder of the bylaw is deemed valid.
- 4. This Bylaw is an amendment to Borrowing Bylaw 188-17.
