We've received the attached agreement from TransAlta for execution by each CAO and Council. The document includes a provision that the G5 would support TransAlta if it proceeds with a hydroelectric project in the future.

Note there is no seals or affidavits required.

Also note that TransAlta requires this agreement before they will sign any pipeline easements or the land sale agreement.
