



Chief Administrative Officer Report January 12, 2023

January 10 - Meeting with Mel Lubeck from Scott Land RE: Water Line Easement

AccuPro Real Estate Appraisal and Consulting has been selected to complete the Village's Industrial land appraisals, with the report to be delivered in January.

I had a meeting with Mel Lubeck from Scott Land and signed off on the Central Peace Regional Water System easement.

I applied for a grant and was successful in getting a complimentary registration to the 2023 CAMA Conference in Ontario at the end of May.

We applied to Service Canada for a Canada Summer Jobs to assist with our Summer Student wage for 2023.

In regards to the Highway 2 and 49 intersection, we did receive another follow up from Global Traffic Group Ltd. They are piloting their latest innovation – Crash Cam, which is a machine learning system that captures collisions and shares video with the police, allowing rapid road reopening, collision reconstruction and cost reduction. It provides a 360-degree view of intersections, capturing collisions 24/7 – supporting Vision Zero and traffic safety/management initiatives. However, after learning about the information that was presented in the Photo Radar RFD that identified the low traffic and incident count, they noted that the intersection would not be a suitable candidate for a test site.

We installed a new door code lock for the Library back door at their request. We are also upgrading the front exterior lighting for better security.
