### **Reason for Presentation \***

On Monday, Lefley Honey Co. will have the authorization to demolish 4626 50 Street (the old nunnery). Since November 1, I have been urging the council to allow a two-week delay to present a business plan for its restoration. While the demolition has been postponed a few times, it's now set for the day before the council meeting. I'm now requesting a two-day delay to allow me to propose a rehabilitation plan.

In the past 4 days, I have connected with community members interested in preserving 4524 50 Street. I created a Facebook page, "Save the Rycroft Nunnery Mission," and distributed flyers to 100 residents. This page has garnered support from local residents; including Cieren Alexander, Kaylea Foster, Brenda Stanich, Ken Connors, Sue Hills, Dolores Karolat Parks, Joyce Babuik, Anne Silvius, Victoria Gordon, and Lawrence Campbell. Additionally, our petition now has 29 signatures from local residents eager to see this historic site preserved.
