Governance and training

- Property Assessment and tax notices were sent out May 13th, 2026

Ongoing projects

- Village Spring clean-up was completed May 8-10th, Public works was still getting calls for pickup on May 13th, when requests were declined.
- Street Sweeping will commence after May long weekend.

Village buildings and assets

- Public works had to repair a damaged sewer connection on 49th street on May 12th.
- Public works had to uncover and repair feeder main from the #43 reservoir to the water treatment plant. Line developed a pressurized leak. Now repaired
- Public works has been busy filling all Village water reservoirs are full eff. May 13th.
- Public works looking at “odor suppression treatments” for Village Lagoon, after complaint received from Environment and Protection.
- Had to remove carcass of dead moose on 55th Street. Alberta Fish and Wildlife would not attend as dead animal was located within Village boundaries.
