### **Governance and training**

- Administration has prepared a flyer to be attached to this years assessment and tax records indicating how Village collects taxes not only for municipal operations but also on behalf of higher levels of government.

### **Ongoing projects**

### **Village buildings and assets**

- Public works has been busy attending to localized flooding within the village,
- All culverts have been cleared for drainage.
- Public works has been busy filling all Village water reservoirs with the spring run-off.
